About artist:

Edin Numankadić

Born on the 13<sup>th</sup> of June 1948 in Sarajevo. Finished primary and high school (Academy of Pedagogic Science, art department) in Sarajevo. Studied the History of Yugoslav Literature at the University of Philosophy in Sarajevo, but his love of painting took him in a different direction, though his love of books and the written word is the inspiration for his art. Won the scholarship "Moša Pijade" twice for the perfection of his art in Paris. Traveled all over the world as an artist. Worked as the long time Secretary of ULUBiH, was a member of the Olympic Committee of Sarajevo and is currently the director of the Olympic Museum of the City of Sarajevo. Member of ULUBiH. Received many awards for his works, such as the "6<sup>th</sup> April" award of the city of Sarajevo, the Nine Dragons award in Korea in 1997 and 2006, third place award for painting in Kuwait in 1996, Grand Prix of the Collegium Artisticum in 2000, and many others. Displayed his works in over 30 independent within the country and abroad and participated in over 300 group exhibitions. His works can be found in the collection of Ars Aevi, the Art Gallery of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Museum of Modern Art in Belgrade, Zagreb, and in many private collections. Participated in numerous symposiums and colonies, and grand international exhibitions such as the Biannual in Venice, Sophia, Nürnberg, Kuwait, Korea. Founder of the group Space Shape and the group Stone.
